The project

The Sciabaca project aims to contest national, European and international policies that have been designed with the objective of restraining the freedom of movement of non-European citizens and the right to asylum. The project purports to provide highly specialized tools to undertake strategic litigation before domestic, European and international courts. In order to carry out these actions, and promote knowledge-exchange and advocacy, the project's goal is to create and strengthen communication and operational platforms between qualified international actors operating in this sector.

From June 2019, the Sciabaca project - which focuses its strategic attention on North African countries (specifically Morocco, Libya, Tunisia, Egypt) - will work in synergy with ASGI Oruka project - which will focus on 5 Sub-Saharan countries (Nigeria, Niger, Chad, Sudan, Ethiopia)

HUMANITARIAN VISAS


Issuing of humanitarian visas for the exercise of the right to reunification, freedom of movement and in cases of illegitimate rejection and expulsion.

ACTIONS AGAINST THE DIVERSION OF FUNDS

Actions against the diversion of Italian and European funds used for illegitimate border control.

COMPENSATION FOR DAMAGE

Compensation for damage due to illegitimate conduct attributable to individual Member States or the European Union concerning the fundamental rights of people in transit in African countries

BILATERAL AGREEMENTS

Promotion of access to bilateral agreements, use of funds, joint actions of member countries and third countries to combat freedom of movement.

CONFERENCES AND ROUND TABLES

International conferences and round tables organized in Italy, in countries of origin and transit - with legal approach and with the aim of creating an international collaboration platform for sharing knowledge and action strategies in view of the collective redefinition of the right to asylum and freedom of movement
